



The Ofcom required SIBC Public File

The entire SIBC website is effectively a public file, containing the required information and more. The following is a guide to the pages with public file content within the SIBC website.

- 1: **News bulletin schedule:**– 159 per week, as listed on the news page and on the schedule page
- 2: **Current news stories:**– the main headlines are posted at http://twitter.com/SIBC_Shettland
- 3: **The news team:**– see the news page for current arrangements
- 4: **Programme schedule:**– this is on the schedule page
- 5: **The average number of hours of automated programming:**– attended play-out is greater than the minimum service duration requirement
- 6: **Amount of local programming:**- 168 hours per week, as is explained on the programming page
- 7: **Ofcom localness guidelines:**– at the Ofcom website <http://www.ofcom.org.uk/>
- 8: **Station contact details:**– this is at the bottom of each web page and it is on the contacts page
- 9: **Events/charities:**– specific causes are supported, otherwise news coverage where appropriate
- 10: **Recent programme/news highlights:**– these are in News about SIBC on the home page or are posted at http://twitter.com/SIBC_Shettland
- 11: **Other issues to impact on localness:**– the ownership of the company is entirely local
- 12: **Playlist:**– The current A lists and B list songs are listed from a link on the home page and new additions are posted when added at http://twitter.com/SIBC_Shettland
- 13: **The station format:**– this is explained on the programming page
- 14: **How to complain:**– write to the managing director at the address at the bottom of each web page
